

Center for Jewish Studies Jewish Community Fellowship Application

The Jewish Community Fellowship provides full tuition for a single course in Jewish Studies at the GTU. Participants in the fellowship will become part of a cohort of students exploring the intersection of critical studies and Jewish communal endeavors. In addition to the course for credit, fellows participate in a two-day workshop on Jewish education led by senior faculty in the field.

Eligibility: Applicants should have at least one year of experience as a Jewish educator or as a Jewish community professional. The fellowship is open only to individuals who are not currently enrolled at the GTU.

Applications: To apply for the fellowship, applicants must submit a 250-word essay in which they describe their work in the Jewish community and how graduate study will serve this broader commitment.

Due Date: Applications are due at least two weeks before the start of each semester. You will be notified by email of your acceptance and given instructions for registration.

To apply for the fellowship, submit this form and send official transcripts showing evidence of your Bachelor's degree as well as any advanced degrees to the Admissions Office. Students holding degrees from non-English speaking institutions will need to submit TOEFL scores.
