



## Verification of Selective Service Registration

Federal law requires males (any person assigned the sex of male at birth) aged 18 to 25 to register with the Selective Service System (SSS). This requirement covers males residing in the United States who are U.S. citizens or noncitizens, except that a male who is in the U.S. as a lawful nonimmigrant isn't required to register as long as he maintains that status. Students who are required to register with the Selective Service must do so in order to be eligible for financial aid. For more information visit [www.sss.gov](http://www.sss.gov).

According to your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the U.S. Department of Education was unable to verify your Selective Service registration or exemption status. - I am a male who is not yet 18 at the time I am completing my application and therefore not yet eligible to register with Selective Service.

### Selective Service Exemption

If you are exempt from registering with Selective Service, please select an exemption below. Please follow all instructions associated with the exemption you select inclusive of submitting additional documentation, if required.

- I was born female (Check your FAFSA at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) to confirm that you answered that you are female and if not, please make the correction.);
- I am a transgender male who was assigned the sex of female at birth (Attach a copy of you Status Information Letter demonstrating your exemption along with a copy of your birth certificate);
- I am/was a noncitizen male who entered the U.S. as a lawful nonimmigrant on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after I turned 26 (For example, if you entered the United States on an F-1 student visa and remained in that status until your 26<sup>th</sup> birthday, you would need to provide documentation indicating that you were admitted on an F-1 visa and attended school full-time as required. Acceptable documentation for this situation includes a copy of your I-20 form or a letter from the school(s) you attended indicating your full-time attendance as a non-immigrant alien. The same requirement applies for all non-immigrant statuses.);
- I am a noncitizen male who first entered the U.S. *after* age 26 (Date of entry stamp in passport, I-94 with date of entry stamp on it, port of entry paperwork, or a letter from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigrations Services (USCIS) indicating the date you entered the United States. If you entered the U.S. illegally after your 26<sup>th</sup> birthday, you must provide proof that you were not living in the U.S. from age 18 through 25. *Please note:* a Resident Alien Card (Green Card) is not valid as proof of the date of entry to the United States);
- I am a male born before 1960 (Official government-issued document showing date of birth such as a state ID card, driver's license, passport, or birth certificate is required);

- I am a male currently in the armed services and on active duty (this exception does not apply to members of the Reserve and National Guard who are not on active duty). Attached is a copy of my DD-214. (If you do not have a copy, you can obtain a copy by contacting the Veteran's Administration at 1-800-827-1000.); or,
- I am a citizen of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Federated States of Micronesia (Attach proof of residency);

There are certain less common situations in which registration isn't necessary. Students who weren't required to register prior to meeting one of these criteria and who meet a criterion for the entire time through the age of 25 qualify for the waiver if:

- I was incarcerated, institutionalized, hospitalized or confined to home from age 18 through 25 (Attach proof of each instance including dates);
- I was enrolled in an officer procurement program at The Citadel, North Georgia College and State University, Norwich University, Virginia Military Institute, Texas A&M University, or Virginia Polytechnic and State University; or,
- I am a commissioned Public Health Service officer on active duty or a member of the Reserve of the Public Health Service on specified active duty.

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By signing this form, I certify that all the information reported to qualify for financial aid is complete and correct. I have included all of the required documentation, and all attachments and supporting documents are true to the best of my knowledge. I further understand that purposely providing false or misleading information or documents is punishable by fine or imprisonment and may make me liable for repayment of any funds received on the basis of the information and documents I have provided. I understand that I may be asked by the GTU Financial Aid Office to provide additional information during the review of this request.
